UPDATES SINCE LAST REPORT:

- The Hydrotherapy programme now runs on Thursday at Moulton College in the early afternoon. The Rotarians (and partners) who have gone along to support those taking part have commented on the experience very positively; fun, friendly and not onerous. Our grant funding will continue to support the programme in January but the BPF branch has secured other funds, including a grant from Popsycle, sufficient to continue on until the summer. The hands-on support given so far has been greatly appreciated and we have been asked to continue to provide that help. The more people helping the better.
- The feature film "Breathe", which is about a polio survivor, was shown at the Castle Theatre on 3rd and 4th December. The management agreed that we, along with the mother club, could promote our End Polio Now work and the British Polio Fellowship both before and after each showing. Our participation was well received and as well as raising the profile of Rotary in Wellingborough we told the polio story and raised a total of £262, which was divided equally between the 2 clubs.
