KEY PROJECTS and GOALS:

Foundation Giving and Sustaining Members.

Members continue to contribute to Foundation giving by way of the Bonus Ball. The individual contributions of a further 3 members of the equivalent of \$100 or more in a year has been recognised by RI with the award of 'Sustaining Member' status, taking our total so recognised to 5.

Polio Awareness End Polio Now Christmas Cards.

An order for 29 packs of cards has now been placed which should result in some £70 being returned to the Hatton Polio account.

BPF Hydrotherapy Project.

A District Foundation Grant for £750 to support the restarting of the hydrotherapy programme has been approved. We await the release of those funds. The grant plus other funds available will cover the cost of 12 sessions. Mike and Kirsten have complete their first one-to-one test of the new facilities ready for the programme to resume later in the year.

Crocus Corms

The box of 4K crocus corms has been delivered and planting took place in the Isebrook Hospital garden on 15th October.
