REPORT FOR CLUB AGM 2022 - 2023

KEY PROJECTS and GOALS:

Foundation Giving including Polio Eradication Funding.

The club Bonus Ball programme has continued throughout the year. Members have been generous in their participation and at least 9 sheets will have been completed by years end generating at least £110 for the fund. In addition, personal contributions, Dogwatch and a rebate from Riviera Travel have taken to total to over £1000 of which £500 has already been sent to the Annual Programme Fund and £200 to End Polio Now. A further donation will be proposed before the end of the year.

BPF Hydrotherapy Project

The hydrotherapy project for polio survivors restarted on a weekly basis in November in the newly refurbished Moulton Leisure Centre. A Foundation grant of £750 was obtained and supplemented by £500 from the club and £250 from the BPF members taking part funded 12 pool sessions. Further funding from Sport England has helped to extend the programme. Direct support has been provided each week by Hatton members and their partners with additional help coming from the Northampton club.

Other Grant Projects

Two collaborative grant projects have been running over the year all allowing Hatton to contribute to larger projects, one in Nepal (Sol water) and the other in Kenya (Little Faces).

Disability Games.

A team of 6 BPF members took part in the D1070 Disability Games held in Lincoln in April with one individual champion and one runner-up in different events. Once again Hatton members and their partners attended to support those participating and a good day was had by all involved.
